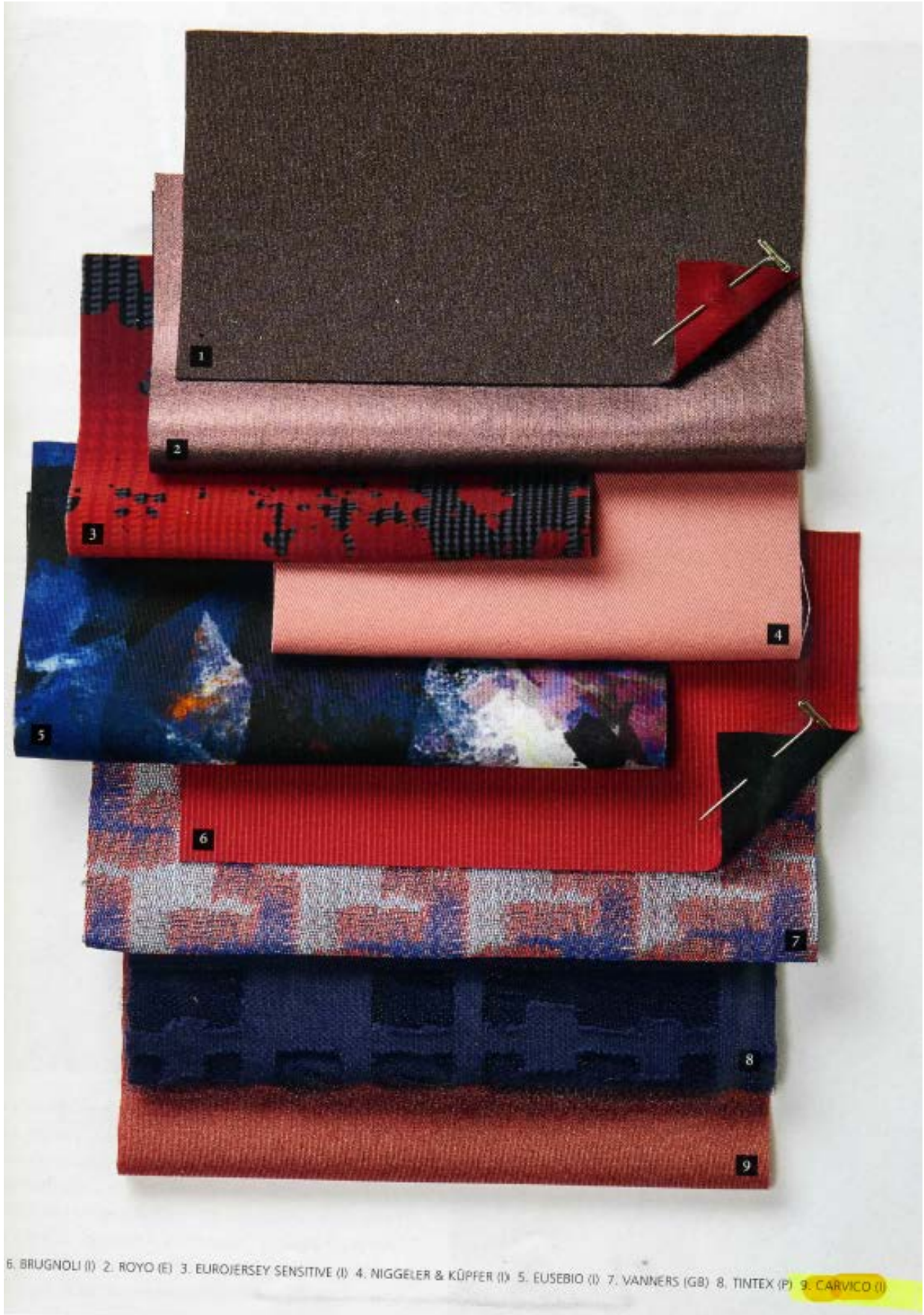


CORAL SEA
